ACTIVATION OF 2ND EMERGENCY RESCUE SQUADRON

1. a. Having been constituted and assigned to this Air Force, the following unit is activated 15 December 1943 at Army Air Base, Hamilton Field, California, and will be organized by the base commander thereat as indicated:

2. Cadre, fillers and replacements will be furnished from sources under control of this Air Force. Personnel replacements will be accomplished in the usual manner by submission of AAF forms 127 A and /or 127 B.

3. Equipment will be in accordance with T/O & E 1 987, 9 November 1943. Priority rating for controlled items of equipment will be C 1 738.

4. Confirmation of activation indicated above will be reported by the base commander concerned by letter to The Adjutant General, furnishing copies to Commanding General, Ninth Service Command, and to Commanding Officer, Engineer Depot, Granite City, Illinois. Confirmation will also be made promptly by TWI to this headquarters.

5. Obligate the appropriate allotments published in Section VI, Circular No. 129, WD, 1 June 1943, to the extent necessary.
